For people thinking of starting up their own businesses in the Midlands, an educational establishment has come up with a novel approach for launching the careers of would-be budding entrepreneurs.

To keep the cost of new premises to a minimum, Lichfield College, affiliated to Staffordshire University, has set up a small business unit where people working in service industries like bookkeeping or graphic design can rent work space.

The unit consists of around a dozen rooms, each set aside for up to four people at a time, all individually furnished with 'agio' desks, one of the most popular multi purpose workstation ranges produced by Eurotek.

Agio has already been successfully introduced to a number of private and public sector work environments and has proved especially popular in the educational field, particularly where large scale student training

courses are required, such as in IT, for instance.

The College's New Business Unit Director Joe Rutherford said: "We are delighted with the way the new premises have worked out. We have been inundated with enquiries and those already in situ seem to be very pleased with the facilities we are able to offer.
